STPRA Applauds Governor Abbott's State of the State Address on Border Security

South Texans' Property Rights Association (STPRA), which represents over 600 owners and managers of more than 5 million acres of land in South Texas, applauds Gov. His announcement today of committing 500 permanent DPS troopers to the border region, adding 20 additional Texas Rangers, and providing additional monies for local law enforcement and border prosecutors will let the criminals know that Texas is serious about border security.
