**ORDER AND JUDGMENT**

**GRANTING FEDERAL DEFENDANTS’ AND INTERVENOR DEFENDANTS’ CROSS-MOTIONS FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT AND DENYING PLAINTIFFS’ MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

For the reasons stated in the Court’s Memorandum Opinion separately issued today, Sally Jewell and Daniel M. Ashe’s (“Federal Defendants”) cross-motion for summary judgment (ECF No. 33), and Susan Combs’s and American Petroleum Institute, Independent Petroleum Association of America, New Mexico Oil and Gas Association, Permian Basin Petroleum Association, and Texas Oil & Gas Association’s (“Intervenor Defendants”) cross-motions for summary judgment (ECF No. 36, 39) are **GRANTED**, and Defenders of Wildlife and Center for Biological Diversity’s motion for summary judgment (ECF No. 19) is **DENIED**.

It is hereby **ORDERED** that **JUDGMENT IS ENTERED** in favor of Federal Defendants and Intervenor Defendants on Plaintiffs’ First Claim and Second Claim.

This is a final, appealable order. *See* Fed. R. App. P. 4(a).
