On 09 JAN, Van Horn USBP Agents and DPS AVN seized **116.70 lbs of marijuana** and apprehended **two IAs** on a ranch, 7 miles southeast of Van Horn. One subject was referred to Culberson Co SO to be charged, and one subject was processed as a voluntary return to MX.

On 23 JAN, Van Horn USBP Agents were notified by DPS AVN of the seizure of **65 lbs of marijuana** that was found abandoned on a ranch, 25 miles west of Valentine. USBP assumed custody of the marijuana bundle, pending referral to Alpine DEA. On 23 JAN, Van Horn USBP Agents received a report from a rancher who encountered three abandoned bundles on their property, 13 miles northwest of Valentine. The Agents took custody of the **85.53 lbs of marijuana** and referred it to Alpine DEA.

On 25 JAN, Van Horn USBP Agents, DPS AVN, and a K-9 Unit responded to a Jeff Davis Co Constable's Office Buckeye camera alert showing three subjects carrying bundles on a ranch, 23 miles south of Van Horn. A total of **139.85 Ibs of marijuana** was found abandoned, and **Drawbridge** cameras showed the three subjects returning to MX. The marijuana was referred to Alpine DEA.







On 10 JAN, Alpine USBP Agents apprehended three IAs in the brush on a ranch, 27 miles southeast of Marathon. A Latin Kings gang member was identified within the group and was charged.

On 20 JAN, Sierra Blanca USBP Agents assisted DPS AVN with the seizure of **243 lbs of marijuana** that was found abandoned on a ranch, 22 miles south of Allamoore. The contraband was referred to DEA.

On 24 JAN, Sanderson USBP Agents apprehended **seven IAs** on a ranch, 19 miles south of Sanderson. A known **smuggler** was identified within the group.



On 05 JAN, a USBP Agent inspected a white 2012 Ford Focus on FM-190, south of Brundage. The vehicle was driven through a ranch fence, when the driver **bailed out** and absconded. The Agent detained **four IAs**, and a Dimmit Co SO Deputy assisted with impounding the vehicle.

On 12 JAN, a USBP Agent was dispatched to a ranch on FM-2688, southeast of Carrizo Springs, regarding a suspicious vehicle. When the Agent arrived, passengers of a silver 2016 Honda CR-V **bailed out** and absconded, and the vehicle was driven through a ranch fence. The driver was arrested by THP Troopers for **human smuggling**, and **three IAs** were apprehended.

On 26 JAN, a USBP Agent apprehended **an IA** walking in the brush on a ranch off of FM-2644, west of Carrizo Springs. A records check indicated the subject was arrested for felony sexual assault in CA, in 2001. The subject was arrested for illegal re-entry of removed aliens and will be processed for removal proceedings.

On 13 JAN, a THP Trooper arrested nine IAs for criminal trespassing on a ranch in Maverick Co.

On 14 JAN, a THP Trooper conducted a traffic stop on a white 2019 Ford F-350 on SH-85, east of Big Wells, when a **pursuit** ensued. The vehicle was driven through a ranch fence, and the vehicle was located abandoned the next day. The vehicle was reported **stolen** from San Antonio.

On 11 JAN, a Zavala Co SO Deputy conducted a traffic stop on a silver 2017 Nissan Titan on US-57, west of La Pryor, when a **pursuit** ensued. The vehicle was driven onto a ranch, when the driver **bailed out**. The subject was detained and identified as **an IA** who was **scouting** for human smugglers. The subject was referred to USBP.

On 14 JAN, a Zavala Co SO Deputy was dispatched to a ranch on FM-117, south of Batesville, regarding a stabbing that occurred at another location. A subject that committed the stabbing admitted to being a Mara Salvatrucha gang member, and was arrested for assault with a deadly weapon. A records check revealed that the subject had a warrant for assaulting a Detention Officer. The stabbing victim was taken to a hospital for treatment.

On 14 JAN, a Dimmit Co SO Deputy was dispatched to a ranch on FM-1557, Asherton, regarding an abandoned blue 2004 Ford Mustang. The Deputy found two syringes with an unidentified narcotic inside the vehicle.

On 15 JAN, a Dimmit Co SO Deputy was dispatched to a ranch regarding an abandoned white 2015 Dodge Ram. The vehicle was reported stolen from San Antonio.

On 31 JAN, a Dimmit Co SO Deputy conducted a traffic stop on a white 2001 Chevrolet Silverado on FM-1557, east of Asherton, when a **pursuit** ensued. The vehicle was driven through a ranch fence when the occupants **bailed out** and absconded. The vehicle was reported **stolen** from San Antonio.

On 27 JAN, a Val Verde Co SO Deputy was dispatched to a ranch off of US-90, west of Langtry, regarding damaged property and stolen items. Security camera footage showed a vehicle registered to a subject with a history of theft from ranches in the surrounding area. Charges were filed at large for the suspect.

On 02 JAN, a THP Trooper conducted a traffic stop on a 2015 red Chevrolet Silverado, when a **pursuit** ensued. The driver and **five IAs bailed out**, and climbed over a ranch fence, when the driver was apprehended. The subject stated he stole the vehicle from his father and claimed to be a **Valluco gang member**.

On 05 JAN, a THP Trooper conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle, when a **pursuit** ensued. The vehicle was driven through a ranch fence, when the occupants **bailed out** and absconded. A DPS Brush Team and USBP Agents located **seven IAs**, who were charged with criminal trespassing.

On 09 JAN, a THP Trooper, TX National Guard Specialists, and a DPS Brush Team arrested **11 IAs** for criminal trespassing on a ranch. Nine subjects were referred to the Jim Hogg Processing Center, and two subjects were referred to Jim Hogg Co Jailers.

On 16 JAN, a THP Trooper conducted a traffic stop on a red 2018 Chevrolet Silverado, when a **pursuit** ensued. Several occupants **bailed out** and absconded onto a ranch. **An IA** was detained after a foot pursuit, and was referred to USBP.

On 16 JAN, a THP Trooper responded to a ranch regarding criminal trespassers, resulting in the arrest of **nine IAs**.

On 16 JAN, a THP Trooper approached a white 2014 Dodge 3500, when it was driven through a patrol gate guard shack on a private ranch, and the driver **bailed out** and absconded. The vehicle was reported **stolen** from San Antonio.

On 17 JAN, a THP Trooper was contacted by a ranch owner regarding a vehicle driven through their property. The vehicle was located, and had been reported **stolen** from San Antonio. On 19 JAN, a THP Trooper responded to a **Drawbridge** alert and conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle. A **pursuit** ensued and the vehicle was driven into the brush on a ranch, where it was located abandoned.

On 20 JAN, a THP Trooper conducted a motorist welfare assist, when 11 occupants **bailed out** and absconded into the brush. The driver sped away and a **pursuit** ensued. The vehicle was driven onto a ranch where it was located abandoned in a pond.

On 27 JAN, a THP Trooper conducted a traffic stop for a window tint violation, when the vehicle accelerated across the roadway and crashed into a ranch fence. Approximately six occupants **bailed out** and absconded. **Two IAs** were detained and referred to USBP.

On 09 JAN, a Duval Co SO Deputy conducted a traffic stop on a tan 2011 Ford F-150, near San Diego, when a **pursuit** ensued. The vehicle was driven onto a ranch where it was located abandoned after the occupants **bailed out** and absconded.

On 12 JAN, La Salle Co SO Deputy encountered a white 2016 Ford F-150 that was driven into a ranch fence. An IA was detained, and nine IAs absconded into the brush. Another IA later surrendered at the entrance of the ranch. The vehicle was reported stolen from San Antonio. On 25 JAN, Cotulla USBP Agents responded to a call for assistance from Frio Co SO, regarding a vehicle **pursuit** and **bailout**. The vehicle was located abandoned on a ranch, and **six IAs** were apprehended. The vehicle was reported **stolen** from Cypress. On 2 JAN, a THP Trooper conducted a traffic stop on a black 2005 Dodge Durango, when a pursuit ensued. The vehicle tires were spiked, when it was driven onto a ranch and visual contact was lost. The vehicle was found abandoned.

On 19 JAN, a THP Trooper conducted a traffic stop on suspected human smuggling vehicle, when a **pursuit** ensued. The vehicle's tires were spiked, and then it was driven onto a ranch. Multiple subjects **bailed out** and absconded into the brush. DPS AVN assisted with the search and guided Troopers to a subject who resisted detainment. A total of **17 IAs** were referred to USBP.

On 22 JAN, a THP Trooper and USBP Agents responded to **Drawbridge** alert, when 10 IAs absconded into the brush. A total of **six IAs** were apprehended. One subject was injured with a possible broken right hand, and the group claimed that two members had been assaulted by a rancher. On 30 JAN, a THP Trooper conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle, when a **pursuit** ensued. The vehicle was driven onto a ranch where a Duval Co SO Deputy found it abandoned.



On 10 JAN and 14 JAN, Brooks Co SO Deputies took reports of **skeletal remains** found on a ranch, near Falfurrias. The remains were transferred to the Brooks Co Evidence Room.



On 27 JAN, a Brooks Co SO Deputy took a report of human remains found on a ranch. The remains and evidence were transported to the Brooks Co SO evidence room.



On 12 JAN, Harlingen USBP Agents apprehended eight IAs on a ranch. A juvenile foot guide was turned over to the MX Consulate.




On 10 JAN, a THP Trooper encountered a white 2016 Ford Fusion with the trunk and doors open, when several occupants **bailed out** and absconded onto a ranch. USBP Agents detected signs of seven subjects in the brush. No apprehensions were made. The vehicle was impounded.

On 28 JAN, Premont PD Officers conducted a traffic stop on a white GMC Sierra, when a **pursuit** ensued. The vehicle was driven onto a ranch where it was found abandoned. On 30 JAN, a Premont PD Officer conducted a traffic stop on a gray 2017 Ford F-150, when a **pursuit** ensued. The vehicle was driven through a ranch gate, when the driver **bailed out** and absconded. The vehicle was located abandoned.




